

TOP 10 MUST-TRY SNACKS

Don't waste your stomach real estate on basic, overpriced theme park food. Ranked from great to life-changing, by Lauren Cotter, Disneyland Paris Silver Passholder.

Pineapple Soft Serve ("Dole Whip")

CAFÉ DE LA BROUSSE, ADVENTURELAND

Everyone knows the famous Dole Whip in the US parks, but Paris has its own twist: a smoother vanilla soft-serve base topped with sweet pineapple sauce or juice. Super refreshing on a warm afternoon after trekking through Adventureland.

Small Chicken Burrito (€7)

CASA DE COCO, ADVENTURELAND

Packed with tender pulled chicken, fresh pico de gallo, guacamole, melted cheese, and cilantro rice, this stuffed burrito delivers incredible value and serious energy for a big park day. It's warm, satisfying, and easily one of the best budget-friendly quick bites in Disneyland Park.

TIP — Pair it with the signature churros for a complete Mexican-inspired quick-service meal on the go.

The Classic Carrot Cake

CABLE CAR BAKE SHOP, MAIN STREET, U.S.A.

When you need to escape the weather on Main Street, this cosy Victorian bakery is elite. Grab a slice and snag a booth inside, or sit in the covered arcades to enjoy it. The cream cheese frosting is made with 100% French Kiri cream cheese, a rich local flair you won't get back home.

Main Street Champagne & The "Mimosa Hack"

OUTDOOR CARTS / GIBSON GIRL ICE CREAM PARLOR

Disneyland Paris is the only Disney park in the world where you can buy a glass of real champagne from an outdoor cart and stroll right up to Sleeping Beauty Castle with it. Around €20, keepsake flute included.

TIP — Grab a small OJ from Market House Deli or Gibson Girl first. Sip the champagne to make room, pour in the OJ: the official Main Street mimosa.

Authentic French Macarons

FANTASYLAND CHALETs & SNACK STALLS

You're in France, don't skip authentic patisserie for a plain pre-packaged cookie. Delicate, beautifully themed, and at around €2 each, one of the cheapest and most cheerful sweet treats in the park.

Fresh Hot Nutella Crêpes

LES CHALETS GOURMANDS

Fresh Nutella crêpes made right in front of you on the hot griddles, served piping hot, folded, and smothered in rich hazelnut spread.

TIP — Skip the Mickey waffles, served cold and underwhelming. The crêpes give you the real French street-food experience.

Fish Fritters with Curried Tartare Sauce

NORDIC CROWNS TAVERN, WORLD OF FROZEN

Four golden, ultra-crispy fish bites paired with a punchy curried sauce. High-end, protein-packed fish nuggets, with a bold savoury kick you don't expect in a theme park.

The Ultimate Croque-Monsieur

MARKET HOUSE DELI, MAIN STREET, U.S.A.

The ultimate French comfort food: melted ham, thick cheese, and rich béchamel sauce between toasted bread, topped with even more melted cheese. Warm, gooey, filling, and easily large enough to split for a quick lunch.

Fresh Burrata & Tomato Salad

ADVENTURE WAY

Theme park food fatigue is real. After a day of sugar and deep-fried eats, a cold, creamy ball of burrata topped with ripe tomatoes, pesto, and balsamic glaze is pure bliss, like a cosy Mediterranean bistro in the middle of your park day.

The Freshly Filled Custard & Strawberry Donut

ADVENTURE WAY

The undisputed number one snack in Disneyland Paris. Piped to order right in front of you with silky pastry cream and topped with fresh strawberries. The contrast between soft dough, cold custard, and sweet fruit makes this the single best bite across both parks.
